- Register online in the NFRA Member Portal or complete PDF form
- Secure your meeting room and sign up to participate in the Speed Meetings all on one registration form!
- Can substitute anytime at no cost
- Can add more attendees later
- There is no official registration deadline, but we encourage early registration for the most benefit

Register at least one representative before the next attendee list is released so that you receive it and can start booking appointments




Accommodations

Reserve a Meeting Room

- Reserve your meeting room(s) during the registration process
- Indicate which day(s) you need the room:
 Available Sunday, Monday, Tuesday
- If applicable, designate a scheduling contact to coordinate your requests

FYI:

Your meeting room location will be available on the mobile app through an interactive floor plan and under **Meeting Rooms**

- Most retailers reserve one room for frozen and one room for refrigerated business appointments; however, you may reserve as many rooms as needed
- NFRA will assign rooms in late summer and promote your location to attendees prior to and during the event



Scheduling Business Meetings

- Set up your meeting schedule:
 - Be sure to schedule your meetings in the local time of the Convention - EST in Orlando, Florida
 - Access the Attendee List via Member Portal or Mobile App
 - View the attendees and note their info
 - Reach out directly via phone or email to request a meeting
 - Coordinate your own schedule with the requests you receive
 - Remember to block out the time for Speed Meetings, if you are participating. These meetings will be coordinated through NFRA.
- Most attendees will come to your room for meetings
- A few larger manufacturers will have their own meeting room; coordinate directly with each company to determine meeting location

Business Meetings Details

- Where do we meet? Most meetings will take place in your assigned room(s)
- **How long are meetings?** NFRA recommends 25 minutes, with five minutes to move between meetings
- How many people attend each meeting? Typically, 1-3 per retailer, up to 5 per manufacturer
- **How do we view presentations?** All rooms have a TV or monitor with HDMI cable connectivity and wi-fi. Please encourage your business partners to come prepared with digital presentations.
- Will attendees bring samples?
 This is up to each manufacturer
- How do we keep track of our meetings?
 This is up to you; NFRA can provide a scheduling template upon request

TIP: Have informal meetings in Café NFRA, meet at Taste of Excellence, or share a meal together during a breakfast or lunch function



Speed Meetings

- Optional opportunity for quick, 6-minute meetings with multiple small, emerging brands.
- Meetings will be offered to small manufacturers and new NFRA members that may
 not have any meetings scheduled or are having trouble obtaining appointments on their own.
 These are companies you may not otherwise see in your day-to-day operations!
- The idea is to create a meet and greet opportunity for sharing of company information and items/brands, setting up follow-up

Tips & Tricks, continued

- New members: Reach out to meet with your mentor and attend the New Member Reception.
- Dress code is business casual.
- Most attendees arrive Saturday to be prepared for early Sunday morning meetings, but this is dependent on your schedule. Business meetings can run as late as 5pm on Tuesday.
- Registration is complimentary for your spouse be sure to register them when you sign up for the Convention.

*Note: "Spouse/Family" is defined as one accompanying a registered attendee but not present for the purpose of conducting business within the frozen and/or refrigerated food industry.
